The OSAVM is a topical meeting, organized by the Vision and Color Division of the Optical Society of America ([www.osa.org](http://www.osa.org)). This year it will be held at the University of Rochester in Rochester, NY. The meeting makes an effort to keep registration costs low, particularly for graduate students and postdocs.
